Dear Mr. Sutton:

The Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed PCS Nitrogen Ohio, L.P.'s letter dated May 22, 2012, which contained a response to DAPC's May 7, 2012, Notice of Violation (NOV). This NOV was for failure to conduct a spray nozzle inspection on the scrubber for emissions unit P524 – urea prilling dryer cyclone with scrubber at least once every 12 months per requirements in the Compliance Assurance Monitoring plan in the facility's Title V permit. The inspection was completed by the company on May 8, 2012, with appropriate documentation submitted.

The violation noted in the NOV has been addressed and is considered resolved. Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for this violation. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
