Our records indicate that Stage II compliance testing occurred at Riveredge Auto Service, 30220 Euclid Ave, Wickliffe, Ohio on October 9, 2007. This annual testing is required to demonstrate compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09(DDD).

This office has no record of this station being tested since and the station should have been tested by October of 2008. Failure to test on an annual basis is a violation of OAC Rule 3745-21-09(DDD). Please schedule any necessary repairs and conduct a retest **within 30 days of your receipt of this letter**. I have enclosed a list of testing companies for your convenience.

Permit-by-Rule

I have enclosed a Permit by Rule Notification form. Please complete the form and return it as per the instructions **within 30 days of your receipt of this letter**. This will replace any needed permit-to-install and operate (PTIO) and will mean you no longer have to pay the biannual emission fees. Failure to submit this form may result in a request to complete PTIO application forms.

Stage II Training

The proof of attendance and completion of the training required by the Ohio EPA for the operator or local manager of the gasoline dispensing facility was not available during the previous test. I have enclosed a copy of the Rule that is applicable to gasoline dispensing facilities as well as a list of testing companies. Some of these companies conduct the Stage II training. **Please schedule this training as soon as possible if you haven't already.**

Failure to comply with this request may result in a referral to the Central Office of Ohio EPA for enforcement action. The submission of the requested information does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in ORC 3704.06. Ohio EPA will decide whether to pursue or decline to pursue penalties regarding this matter at a later date.
