Dear Mr. Gill:

The annual Stage II compliance demonstration conducted at Redi Go Food Mart located at 148 South Broadway in Geneva, Ohio on February 22, 2010 failed to demonstrate compliance with the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09(DDD).

During the above-mentioned test, the static leak was unable to pass. Also, the nozzle on dispenser #2 could not be tested for the air-to-liquid ratio as it was inoperable.

Also, this office has no record of testing being performed at this facility for the 2008 and 2009 calendar years.

Failing a test and failure to have testing performed annually constitute violations of OAC Rule 3745-21-09(DDD).

Please make repairs and schedule a retest as soon as possible.

Other violations

The proof of attendance and completion of the training required by the Ohio EPA for the operator or local manager of the gasoline dispensing facility was not available during this year's test. I have enclosed a copy of the Rule that is applicable to gasoline dispensing facilities as well as a list of testing companies. Some of these companies conduct the Stage II training. **Please schedule and complete this training within forty-five (45) days of receipt of this letter.** Failure to comply is a violation of OAC Rule 3745-21-09(DDD).

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During this year's testing our inspector also noted that the maintenance records are not being maintained properly in violation of OAC Rule 3745-21-09(DDD). **Please be sure to maintain this record keeping in an orderly fashion.**

Issuance of this Notice of Violation does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in ORC 3704.06. Ohio EPA will decide whether to pursue or decline to pursue penalties regarding this matter at a later date.
