The annual Stage II compliance demonstration conducted at Pilot Travel Centers LLC002 located at 2246 Rt. 45 in Austinburg, Ohio 44010 on December 10, 2009, and February 12 and March 12, 2010, demonstrated compliance with the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09(DDD).

The next annual Stage II compliance test is due in January 2011.

Summary of 2010 testing violations

On December 10, 2009, an annual test was attempted (for calendar year 2010), but the static leak failed and the air-to-liquid ratio test failed for dispensers #3, #4, & #7.

Testing was attempted again on February 12, 2010 and the air-to-liquid ratio test passed, but the static leak test still failed.

Testing was attempted again on March 12, 2010 and the static leak test passed.

Summary of 2009 testing violations

On January 12, 2009, a five-year test was attempted, but the static leak and dynamic pressure tests failed due to poor maintenance.

Testing was attempted again on January 27, 2009 and passed the static leak and dynamic pressure tests.

Summary of 2008 testing violations

This office has no record of testing being conducted for calendar year 2008 for this station.



The above testing failures constitute violations of OAC Rule 3745-21-09(DDD). This matter will be referred to the Central Office of Ohio EPA for possible enforcement action.

Issuance of this Notice of Violation does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in ORC 3704.06. Ohio EPA will decide whether to pursue or decline to pursue penalties regarding this matter at a later date.
