RE: Warning Letter for Operating an Air Pollution Source prior to applying for Permits-to-Install and Permits-to-Operate (PTIO) at the Bessemer Concrete facility in Petersburg, Ohio.

Dear Mr. Parrott:

The purpose of this letter is to follow up my recent site visit of August, 21, 2008, and our subsequent conversations concerning Bessemer Concrete's facility in Petersburg, Ohio. These conversations dealt with that facility operating an air pollution source prior to applying for and receiving the required permits-to-install and permits-to-operate (PTIO).

Please be advised that Rule 3745-31-02 of the Ohio Administrative Code states, in part, "Except as provided in rule 3745-31-03 of the Administrative Code, no person shall cause, permit, or allow the...Installation or modification, and subsequent operation of any new source... without first obtaining a PTIO from the director..."

Be advised that violations of state air pollution regulations are punishable by civil penalty of \$25,000 per violation. This is, therefore, an official notice requiring the submittal of applications for PTIO, for any such air contaminant source at your facility. In order to move toward compliance, please submit the appropriate application(s) to my attention within **30 days of receipt of this letter**. We trust that voluntary compliance will be forthcoming so that no further action will be required.

The submission of the requested permit applications (PTIO) does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in ORC 3704.06. Ohio EPA will make a decision whether to pursue or decline to pursue penalties regarding this matter at a latter date.
