RETURN TO COMPLIANCE
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER

Dear Ms. Palazzi:

On 1/5/12, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) sent Scirra, Inc. dba Dry Cleaning Specialties, located at 5151 W. 137th St. in Brookpark an Annual Permit Evaluation Report (PER) submission reminder letter indicating the due date for the reporting period 1/1/11 through 12/31/11 was 2/15/12.

On 3/1/12, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a PER overdue letter and included a PER form for completion. A submission date of 3/16/12 was established to avoid further enforcement action.

On 3/28/12, CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) for failure to submit the Annual PER. An additional PER form was included. A written response was requested within fourteen (14) days of receipt of the NOV.

On 5/1/12, CDAQ issued a Second NOV documenting that a PER form was mailed to the address noted above on 1/5/12 with the due date indicated as 2/15/12. And, that an additional copy of the PER form was included with the first Notice of Violation (NOV) dated 3/28/12 and was enclosed with this second NOV. A written response was requested within fourteen (14) days of receipt of the Second NOV.

On 6/5/12, CDAQ personnel spoke with you by telephone and clarified the necessity of immediate submission of the Annual PER in order to avoid enforcement action.

CDAQ is in receipt of a facsimile of a completed Annual PER form dated 6/5/12.

The Annual PER was received and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. 
