RETURN TO COMPLIANCE  
NOTICE OF VIOLATION/ NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER

Dear Mrs. Keun Kim:

On May 8 and June 7, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Bil-Mar Drycleaners (Bil-Mar) located at 6110 Royalton Road in North Royalton. This letter serves as notification that you operated a source in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

Bil-Mar is in violation of D001: Dry Cleaning Machine, Permit Number P0106868, C. Emissions Unit Terms and Conditions, d) Monitoring and/or Recordkeeping Requirements for:

- (4)(c) not calculating the yearly perchloroethylene consumption 12-month rolling summation;
- (4)(d) not maintaining leak check records;
- (4)(f) not recording the date and temperature sensor monitoring or pressure gauge reading results as required and;
- (4)(h) not measuring the amount of fabric dry cleaned with perchloroethylene, from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

These are also violations of 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 63.322(k), 63.323(a)(1), 63.324(d)(1) and (2), and Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.05(C).

Since May 8, 2012, Bil-Mar Drycleaners has maintained records of perchloroethylene consumption, dates or repairs and orders for repairs, record the date and temperature sensor monitoring or pressure gauge, and amount of fabric dry cleaned. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
