Dear Ms. Gray:

The annual Stage II compliance test conducted at Town & Country Co-op located at 210 Huron St. in Elyria, Ohio on July 29, 2008 failed to demonstrate compliance for the following parameters:

<u>Parameter</u>	<u>Pass/Fail</u>
A/L Test	Failed on dispenser #1
Static Leak Test	Passed
Dynamic Pressure Test	Not required this year
Ohio EPA Inspection	Passed

The A/L test failed due to a new vacuum motor being needed.

The proof of attendance and completion of the training required by the Ohio EPA for the operator or local manager of the gasoline dispensing facility was not available. I have enclosed a copy of the Rule that is applicable to gasoline dispensing facilities as well as a list of testing companies. Some of these companies conduct the Stage II training. We will expect that the training be completed prior to your next Stage II test.

Please schedule repairs and conduct a retest within 14 days of your receipt of this letter.

Failed test results constitute a violation of OAC Rule 3745-21-09 (DDD).

Violations of state air pollution control regulations are punishable by a civil penalty of \$25,000 per violation. Issuance of this notice does not excuse any violation of state law regarding air pollution. An enforcement action will be initiated if this site does not return to compliance within 14 days of your receipt of this letter.
