Dear Mr. Putnam:

This letter shall serve to resolve the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to the above referenced facility on May 17, 2012. The Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed the company's letter dated June 15, 2012, which responded to the NOV that was generated following a complaint investigation conducted on May 15, 2012. Back in Black has addressed the violations identified in the NOV with the following:

- (1) R028 - Monthly VOC Records: The company addressed the requirement to maintain monthly VOC records for Spray Booth #1 by submitting a copy of the data sheet on which the required information will be recorded.
- (2) R028 - Dry Particulate Filtration Inspection Records: While the company could not provide existing documentation at the time of the complaint investigation, the company addressed this issue by providing the maintenance log which documented inspections prior to our visit.
- (3) R028 – Foam Presses Evaluation: The previous owner had an evaluation performed and determined that no permits were required. The current company has committed to reevaluating the permit exemption status of the foam presses as a precautionary measure. The evaluation is scheduled for the end of July and the determination will be submitted to my attention once it is completed.

The violation(s) noted in the NOV letter have been addressed and considered resolved. Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for these violation(s). The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
