Subject: Elyria Foundry (facility I.D. #0247040014) failed to submit the required Title V compliance certification in violation of the Title V permit terms and conditions and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-77-07(C)(5).

Dear Mr. Byrne:

The purpose of this letter is to bring to your attention that Elyria Foundry failed to submit a compliance certification for the calendar year 2007 period by April 30, 2008, in violation of OAC rule 3745-77-07(C)(5), the terms and conditions of your Title V Permit (Part I. A.), and Revised Code (RC) Section 3704.05(C). It is important that your company immediately prepare and submit this required compliance certification as soon as possible, but not later than 30 days from receipt of this letter. The compliance certification forms, instructions, and examples are available on Ohio EPA's world wide web site at the following address:

If you fail to submit this Title V compliance certification by the deadline, we will have no choice but to refer this matter to Columbus for appropriate enforcement action that would likely include the assessment of civil penalties. The submission of this compliance certification does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in RC Chapter 3704.
