Dear Mr. Lee:

This letter shall serve as a follow-up to the Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated May 2, 2012. The NOV was based on US EPA Method 22 observations that were taken on April 23, 2012, pertaining to a complaint investigation lodged against Chambers Leasing Systems (herein referred to as CLS) on April 20, 2012. A compliance plan was submitted by CLS on May 17, 2012, as a response to the NOV letter. In addition, daily records have been submitted documenting water usage on the unpaved roadways and parking areas.

CLS is considered to have returned to compliance based on the submittals. In addition, please note that it is no longer necessary for daily reports to be submitted at this time. It should be stressed however, that CLS needs to follow the requirements in the issued permit (PTIO #P0105115 issued on October 28, 2009). The requirements include maintaining daily records of inspections of the roadways and parking areas. As the permit states, "the purpose of the inspections is to determine the need for implementing" control measures such as watering and chemical stabilization. The failure to maintain these records would be a violation of the permit terms and conditions.
