**RETURN TO COMPLIANCE  
NOTICE OF VIOLATION / NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Falconbery:

On May 25, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Sunoco Logistics Partners L.P. (Sunoco Logistics) at 3200 Independence Road in Cleveland. During the inspection, CDAQ informed Sunoco Logistics about the failure to submit your 2011 Title V Compliance Certification and your first quarter deviation report for 2012, via Ohio EPA's eBusiness Center called "Air Services." Hard copies of each report were received by CDAQ on March 19, 2012, and May 21, 2012, respectively. However, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-15-03(A), [t]he director may require the keeping and periodic submission or records and reports...in a manner and form prescribed by the director." Beginning with the fourth quarter 2008, Ohio EPA has required Title V and Synthetic Minor facilities to submit such reports and certifications via Air Services.

Subsequent to CDAQ's inspection, Sunoco Logistics submitted their 2011 Title V Compliance Certification and the first quarter deviation report for 2012 via Air Services on May 25, 2012, and June 5, 2012, respectively.

Appropriate steps were taken to bring Sunoco Logistics into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
