**RETURN TO COMPLIANCE
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Neeley:

On April 17, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected BFI-Glenwillow located at 30300 Pettibone Road in Glenwillow. CDAQ then issued a Notice of Violation on April 30, 2012, requesting that BFI-Glenwillow submit a Permit-by-Rule (PBR) Notification form for the Kohler 85 kW emergency electrical generator; an updated Title V permit application listing all insignificant emissions units (EUs); and an EU withdrawal form for insignificant units that are permanently shut down, which was enclosed in the Notice of Violation. CDAQ then received a request dated May 25, 2012, at which time BFI-Glenwillow requested an additional thirty (30) days to address all issues of noncompliance.

On June 1, 2012, CDAQ issued a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan (RCAP) letter requiring BFI-Glenwillow to submit a PBR Notification form for the Kohler 85 kW emergency electrical generator; an updated Title V permit application listing all insignificant EUs; and an emissions unit withdrawal form for insignificant units that are permanently shut down by July 3, 2012.

CDAQ is in receipt of a PBR Notification form for the Kohler 85 kW emergency electrical generator and an emissions unit withdrawal form for insignificant units that have been permanently shut down on July 2, 2012. The Title V permit application now accurately reflects the insignificant emissions units for BFI-Glenwillow.

The corrective action plan was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
