Mr. Curry:

On 13 December 2007, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Zaclon Inc. submit permit to install application for emission unit P005 and submit monthly reports of zinc chloride solution and its methanol weight shipments received. CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action plan dated 17 January 2008. You are expected to comply with submitting the application by 1 March 2008. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
