RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

Dear Mr. Fussner:

On February 24, 2011, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) to Standard Signs, Inc., which requested the submittal of a permit-to-install/operate (PTIO) application for the operation of a paint booth using solvent-based coatings. The NOV required a PTIO application submittal to Ohio EPA within thirty days of your receipt of the NOV. The return receipt from the NOV shows a delivery date of March 7, 2011 to Standard Signs, Inc.; thus, a PTIO application was due no later than April 6, 2011.

CDAQ is in receipt, however, of a letter dated March 9, 2011. The letter stated that PTIO applications were almost complete for both the Cleveland and Macedonia locations, and that after you received your PIN number from Ohio EPA's e-Business Center, you would proceed with the online PTIO filing.

You are expected to comply with submitting the appropriate PTIO application(s) by April 25, 2011. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
