NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER: FAILURE TO SUBMIT 2006/2007
CITY PERMIT FEES AND FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH PERMIT MONITORING AND
RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENTS


On January 15, 2009, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requiring Ferro Corporation - Polymer Additives Division Plant #1 (Ferro Plant #1) to submit 2006/2007 city permit fees and a one month hardcopy sample of monthly visible emissions (VE)/leak check records for emission units (EUs) P001, P006 and P020. CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action plan dated January 23, 2009, that provides a one month hardcopy sample of monthly VE/leak checks for EUs P001, P006 and P020 as well as weekly checks of all production lines.

In addition, CDAQ is in receipt of a check for 2006/2007 city permit fees for EUs B001, B003, B004, B005, P001, P003, P004, P006, P014, P015, P016, P017, P020, P023, P024, P025, P026, P032, P033, P034, P035, P036, P037, P038, P039, T001 and T002 dated February 4, 2009.

The corrective action plan was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
