RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Conlon:

On June 3, 2009, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) requesting that Stein, Inc. (Stein) submit a corrected annual Title V Compliance Certification within 14 days of receipt of this letter, pay 2006, 2007 and 2008 city permit fees and submit electronic 2009 first quarter deviation reports. Title V facilities have been required to submit quarterly deviation reports electronically since last quarter 2008.

CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action plan letter dated June 12, 2009, stating Stein would amend its "Annual Report" for 2008 and resubmit through the Ohio EPA eBusiness Center. It has yet to be submitted.

Stein also stated in the letter that a late submission (deviation report) for the first quarter 2009 would be made immediately. It has yet to be submitted.

CDAQ is in receipt of 2006, 2007 and 2008 city permit fees paid dated June 15, 2009. Thank you.

You are still expected to comply by submitting a 2008 corrected annual Title V Compliance Certification and 2009 first quarter deviation report within 7 days of receipt of this letter. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.

Also, in the letter it states that the 2032 Campbell Road address is a field office for onsite employees and the East 45<sup>th</sup> Street address has historically been the main business office for Stein's operation at the steel mill. CDAQ is stating that the physical address of your facility needs to be on Stein's annual Title V Compliance Certification.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of



local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
