RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Conlon:

On June 3, 2009, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Stein, Inc. (Stein) submit a corrected 2008 Title V Compliance Certification within 14 days of receipt of the letter, pay 2006, 2007 and 2008 city permit fees and submit electronic 2009 first quarter deviation reports.

CDAQ is in receipt of paid city permit fees dated June 15, 2009. CDAQ sent a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan letter dated July 6, 2009, requesting submittal of a corrected 2008 Title V Compliance Certification and electronic 2009 first quarter deviation report.

CDAQ is in receipt of the electronic submittal of 2009 first and second quarter deviation reports and a semi-annual report dated August 3, 2009.

You are still expected to comply with submitting a corrected, electronic 2008 Title V Compliance Certification within 7 days of receipt of this letter. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
