NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failure to submit permit-to install/operate (PTIO) applications for replacement equipment, failure to submit quarterly deviation reports, failure to submit a permit-to-operate (PTO) renewal application.

Dear Mr. Meintel:

On 12/8/08, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Custom Clutch, Joint & Hydraulics, Inc. (CCJH) located at 3417 St. Clair Ave. in Cleveland, OH. This letter serves as notification that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

CCJH is in violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.05(F) and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-31-02 for failure to submit plans and permit applications prior to installation and operation of the Kelco unit that replaced the Goff Air-Less Blaster (P001) in 2002.

CCJH's operation of emissions unit (EU) P006: Gas Fired Pyrolysis Oven (300,000 Btu/hr) with afterburner, is also in violation of ORC 3704.05(C), OAC 3745-15-03(A) and the permit-to-operate (PTO) assigned to permit-to-install (PTI) #13-2432, for failure to submit Quarterly Deviation Reports since issuance of the PTO on 4/3/97, and failure to submit a PTO renewal application upon expiration of the original PTO on 4/3/00.

CCJH will need to provide documentation for EUs P002, P003, P004 and P005 to supplement determination of these sources as "de minimis" (OAC 3745-15-05) or "exempt" (OAC 3745-31-03). Otherwise, permit-to-install/operate (PTIO) applications may be required.

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that Custom Clutch, Joint & Hydraulics, Inc. submit PTIO applications for the new Kelco Steel Shot Blaster (P001), the Pyrolysis Oven (P006), and adequate records or calculations to establish "de minimis" or "exempt" status for the remaining active EUs (P002-P005) to the following enforcement representative:

Your written response to this letter must be received by CDAQ within fourteen (14) days of your receipt of this letter. If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, your response must include a timeline for correcting the alleged violations.

The appropriate permit application(s) and supplemental form(s) are included with this letter. Please note that all permit applications submitted to CDAQ must include original signatures. Photocopied signatures are not valid; the application will not be accepted by CDAQ and will be returned to you if original signatures are not provided.

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

Free assistance with state and/or federal regulations, rules, laws or permit conditions can be provided at no charge through the Ohio EPA Office of Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention (OCAPP). OCAPP can be contacted at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/ocapp> or (614) 644-3469 or (800) 329-7518.

CDAQ makes no guarantee that the facility will meet the qualifying guidelines established by OCAPP.

OCAPP can also provide assistance to facilities that want to investigate methods of pollution prevention to reduce raw material usage and waste production. Again, there is no charge for their services.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. 
