NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failure to obtain a 2007, 2008 and 2011 City of Cleveland Air Contaminant Source permit for emissions unit (EU) R001; 2006 through 2011 City of Cleveland Air Contaminant Source permits for EUs P001 and K002; and 2009 through 2011 City of Cleveland Air Contaminant Source permit for EU P002

Dear Mr. Heran:

On August 19, 2011, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Armature Coil Equipment Co. (Armature Coil) located at 4725 Manufacturing Avenue in Cleveland. This letter serves as notification that you are operating a source in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

CDAQ has not received the City of Cleveland Air Contaminant Source fees for EUs P001: 64 feet³ gas burn-off oven, P002: 125 feet³ gas burn-off oven, R001: paint spray booth and K002: paint spray booth, small black one. This is in violation of City of Cleveland Codified Ordinances 259.01 and 263.01. The following matrix compares receipt of city permit fees and EUs. An "X" indicates receipt of city permit fees:

CDAQ acknowledges that Air Contaminant Source fees were paid for EU R001 for 2006, 2009 and 2010. The enclosed invoices note it next to "Amount Paid". Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that Armature Coil obtain a City of Cleveland Air Contaminant Source permit by submitting the fees to the following address:

Your written response to this letter must be received by CDAQ within 21 days of your receipt of this letter. If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, your response must include a timeline for correcting the alleged violations.

The permit invoices are included with this letter. Please note that all invoices submitted to CDAQ must include original signatures. Photocopied signatures are not valid; the invoice will not be accepted by CDAQ and will be returned to you if original signatures are not provided.

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
