RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: Operating emission units without permits

Dear Mr. Cook:

On September 28, 2010, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) requesting that Cook Bonding and Manufacturing (Cook) submit a Permit-to-Install/Operate (PTIO) application for the Heat Cleaning Oven or calculations proving the Heat Cleaning Oven to be "De Minimis" status and obtain city permits for the Emission Unit (EU) P001: wheelabrator, tumble blast cleaning machine manufactured by Pangborn, installed in 1987, for calendar years 2007, 2008 and 2009 as well as city permit fees for the Heat Cleaning Oven and the second Wheelabrator, tumble blast cleaning machine manufactured by Wheelabrator installed in 2005, for calendar years 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 within 30 days of the receipt of the NOV.

CDAQ is in receipt of city permit fees as of October 26, 2010. You are still expected to comply with submitting a Permit-to-Install/Operate (PTIO) application for the Heat Cleaning Oven or calculations proving the Heat Cleaning Oven to be "De Minimis" status by November 22, 2010. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Photocopied signatures are not valid; the application will not be accepted by CDAQ and will be returned to you if original signatures are not provided.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
