NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER

Dear Ms. Nelson:

On September 22, 2009, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) requiring St. Clair Shell to obtain city permits to operate by submitting city permit fees for 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 and to perform annual Static Leak and Air-to-Liquid Ratio tests.

CDAQ received city permit fees dated November 4, 2009. On November 5, 2009, St. Clair Shell performed annual Stage II testing and failed the Static Leak test and Air-to-Liquid Ratio tests on pumps #1 through #8.

On November 6, 2009, CDAQ issued a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan (RCAP) stating that St. Clair Shell was expected to perform a Static Leak retest and Air-to-Liquid Ratio retest on pumps #1 through #8 by December 5, 2009.

On January 22, 2010, CDAQ issued a Second Notice of Violation requiring St. Clair Shell to perform and pass the required annual Stage II testing (Static Leak test and Air-to-Liquid Ratio retest on pumps #1 through #8) by February 28, 2010.

CDAQ is in receipt of passing Static Leak and Air-to-Liquid Ratio tests dated February 4, 2010.

The corrective action plan was received and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
