**RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: Failure to conduct annual Static Leak and Air-to-Liquid tests, and failure to obtain city permits-to-operate and pay city permit fees for 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009**

Dear Ms. Nelson:

On September 22, 2009, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that St. Clair Shell obtain city permits-to-operate by paying city permit fees for calendar years 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 and perform a Static Leak test and Air-to-Liquid test. CDAQ is in receipt of city permit fees for calendar years 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 dated November 4, 2009. However, St. Clair Shell failed both the Static Leak test and Air-to-Liquid test on pumps #1 through #8 on November 5, 2009.

You are expected to perform the Static Leak retest and Air-to-Liquid retest on pumps #1 through #8 by December 5, 2009. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
