RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Wolf:

On May 12, 2010, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that SPS Technologies, LLC (SPS) submit a Permit-to-Install/Operate application for EU P007: Heat Treating Line #3, Natural Gas 6.6 MMBTU/HR Max. In addition, CDAQ requested SPS submit Permit-to-Install/Operate applications for EU Z004: Wheelabrator Grit Blaster, EU Z009: Machining Operations and EU Z010: Paved Roadways or provide acceptable emission calculations for these emission units within thirty (30) days of receipt of the May 12, 2010 Notice of Violation.

CDAQ is in receipt of a request for a deadline extension to July 19, 2010, dated June 14, 2010. You are expected to comply with submitting a Permit-to-Install/Operate application for EU P007: Heat Treating Line #3, Natural Gas 6.6 MMBTU/HR Max. as well as submit Permit-to-Install/Operate applications for EU Z004: Wheelabrator Grit Blaster, EU Z009: Machining Operations and EU Z010: Paved Roadways or provide acceptable emission calculations for these emission units by July 19, 2010.

Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Sorry about the number of emails but I am throwing these questions out as I come across them. It has come to my attention that we do not have state permits for Emission Unit (EU) Z004 (Wheelabrator Grit Blaster) and EU Z010 (Paved Roadways) in addition to EU Z009 (Machining Operations). If you have a copy of the state permits and you could forward them to me it would be much appreciated. Otherwise each unit will require permit applications. ( I included Z010 (the paved roadways) because I believe I told you that it was on registration status. Upon reviewing the records, it appears that Z010 was never permitted.)
