NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Dottore:

On September 21, 2009, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation letter requiring Harvard Refuse, Inc. to obtain city permits-to-operate by submitting city permit fees and prevent the flares on site from causing an odor nuisance because they were venting emissions without a flare present.

On November 2, 2009, a Second Notice of Violation letter was issued to Harvard Refuse, Inc. but was returned to CDAQ unclaimed.

On March 9, 2010, CDAQ met with representatives from Dottore Companies LLC, the new receiver of the property, in the downstairs meeting room of the Cuyahoga Heights Village Hall to discuss corrective actions that needed to take place.

On March 18, 2009, CDAQ issued a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan letter requesting court-mandated monthly progress reports and weekly explosive gas monitoring reports for the month of April. City permit fees for calendar years 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009 were considered paid and up to date due to the fact that several emissions units no longer exist.

CDAQ is in receipt of three months' worth of court-mandated monthly progress reports and weekly explosive gas monitoring reports dated June 21, 2010.

A site visit was made on June 28, 2010 to confirm the reports that all three flares on the site had flames present and were operating properly.



Corrective action plans were received and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
