NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failure to submit quarterly deviation reports, failure to retain maintenance and ash removal records, failure to establish minimum temperature requirement, failure to post permit terms and conditions near the incinerator and failure to obtain city permits to operate by submitting city permit fees for calendar years 2006, 2007 and 2008

Dear Mr. Murphy:

On June 7, 2010, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) responded to an odor complaint regarding Greenfield Crematory located at 5475 Lake Court in Cleveland. This letter serves as notification that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

Greenfield Crematory has not submitted quarterly deviation reports to CDAQ since October 3, 2007. This is a violation of N001: Crematory furnace/human remains' Permit to Operate (PTO) Part I. 3. a. and b.

Greenfield Crematory failed to provide any records on site regarding maintenance and ash removal, which is a violation of N001's PTO Part II. C. 2. and 3.

Greenfield Crematory also fails to get N001 up to the minimum requirement of 1600 degrees Fahrenheit, according to temperature gauge records. Zack Nicol stated during the site visit that he feeds the incinerator when the temperature reaches 800 degrees Fahrenheit. This is a violation of N001's PTO Part II. B.1.a. and b.

Greenfield Crematory also failed to visibly post a copy of N001's PTO terms and conditions near the incinerator, which is a violation of N001's PTO Part II. F. 1.



Greenfield Crematory also has not obtained city permits-to-operate by submitting city permit fees for calendar years 2006, 2007 and 2008. This is a violation of City of Cleveland Codified Ordinances 259.01 and 263.01.

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that Greenfield Crematory submit a quarterly deviation report for 3rd quarter (July through September) 2010 (and continue to do so on a quarterly basis into the future), maintenance and ash removal records to the following enforcement representative:

CDAQ also requests that Greenfield Crematory obtain city permits-to-operate by submitting city permit fees for calendar years 2006, 2007 and 2008 within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this letter to the following address:

In addition, CDAQ requests that Greenfield Crematory visibly post N001's permit terms and conditions near the incinerator as soon as possible and that a follow-up site visit be scheduled to verify if the incinerator is capable of reaching the 1600 degrees Fahrenheit minimum temperature requirement specified in N001's PTO Part II.B.1.a. and b.

Your written response to this letter must be received by CDAQ within fourteen (14) days of your receipt of this letter. If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, your response must include a timeline for correcting the alleged violations.

The appropriate permit application(s) and supplemental form(s) are included with this letter. Please note that all permit applications submitted to CDAQ must include original signatures. Photocopied signatures are not valid; the application will not be accepted by CDAQ and will be returned to you if original signatures are not provided.

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
