NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER

Dear Mr. Schoenmeyer:

On December 30, 2009, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requiring Abel to submit Permit to Install/Operate applications for the unpermitted emission units located at Abel. CDAQ is in receipt of a letter dated April 13, 2010, that provided emissions data to prove De Minimis status for state operating permits for each unpermitted emission unit located at Abel. CDAQ sent a letter dated April 23, 2010 stating that Abel must obtain City of Cleveland permits-to-operate for 10 tanks.

The corrective action plan was received and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance with state regulations. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time regarding state issues, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ still requests that Abel obtain City of Cleveland permits-to-operate by submitting city permit fees. As discussed via telephone with JoAnn Kern of Abel, CDAQ requests that payments be made in monthly installments beginning in May of 2010 and continuing through July 30, 2010. All payments must be received by July 30, 2010. Payments should be sent to the following address:
