NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NOV)/ NOV FOLLOW-UP LETTER: Failure to Obtain a
Permit-to-Install/Operate (PTIO) for a New Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaning Machine**

Dear Mr. Malasi:

On 4/13/12, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Westwood Dry Cleaners (Westwood) located at 15520 Detroit Avenue in Lakewood. This letter serves as notification that you were operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

Westwood moved from the 15525 Detroit Avenue location and dismantled/removed your old perchloroethylene dry cleaning machine effective 9/1/11.

Westwood failed to obtain a PTIO for a Firbimatic Axial 40 dry-to-dry perchloroethylene dry cleaning machine that was installed at your new location (15520 Detroit Avenue) in August of 2011. This is a violation of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.03 and the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-31-02.

At the time of the site visit you provided the inspector with a completed PTIO application that had been given to you by the vendor of the new dry cleaning machine. You explained that you thought he had submitted the application and that this was a copy for your records.

CDAQ has processed the application and a new PTIO was issued effective on 4/26/12.

Please review the new PTIO upon receipt and familiarize yourself with the terms and conditions. It is your responsibility to comply with all operational, recordkeeping and reporting requirements.



The corrective action plan was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
