INSTALL/OPERATE APPLICATION AND FAILURE TO SUBMIT WRITTEN ANNUAL
REPORTS**

Dear Mr. Constant:

On 8/18/10, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Essroc Cement Corp. submit a permit-to-install/operate (PTIO) application for emissions units F001 and P901, and submit annual written reports regarding parking lot and roadway inspections. CDAQ received a letter dated 9/24/10 requesting a deadline extension. The letter also indicated the number of inspections completed in 2009.

CDAQ grants an extension to 11/5/2010; you are expected to submit the PTIO application by that date. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
