NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. English:

On January 31, 2011, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requiring Ganley Auto Collision Centers (Ganley) to submit records of maintenance, documentation of exhaust stack compliance, and a corrective action plan demonstrating how devices which store paint and cleaning waste are to be maintained as required in the future. CDAQ also requested that Ganley submit the paint usage records for January 14, 2011 in addition to the Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for the materials used on that day.

CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action plan dated February 28, 2011 at which time CDAQ received paint usage records dated January 14, 2011 in addition to the Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for the materials used on that day. CDAQ also received a schedule of filter maintenance for the Spray Bake paint booth.

CDAQ then issued a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan (RCAP) on March 8, 2011 requesting Ganley submit documentation of exhaust stack compliance, and a corrective action plan demonstrating how devices which store paint and cleaning waste will be maintained in the future as required. Additionally, CDAQ requested that Ganley submit paint usage records for the following timeframe of January 9, 2011 through January 22, 2011.

CDAQ received paint usage records for January 9, 2011 through January 23, 2011 in addition to documentation that paint waste storage containers will be closed when not in use on March 23, 2011. CDAQ also received specifications which demonstrate compliance for the exhaust stack at this time.

Appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
