**SECOND RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: Exceeding emission
limitations, violating terms and conditions of permit-to-install #13-03966**

Dear Mr. Cannata:

On April 14, 2011, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Cansto Paint and Varnish Company (Cansto) submit the following:

- A plan of corrective action to completely cover the mixing/blending tanks while containing paint materials.
- As well as corrected quarterly deviation reports for each quarter in 2010 either electronically via the e-Business Center, Air Services, or to the following enforcement representative, within 30 thirty days of receipt of the Notice of Violation:

Also, CDAQ requested that Cansto electronically submit:

- A Title V permit-to-operate application as well as PTI modification permit applications for emissions units P001, P002, P003, P004, P005, P006, P007 and P008 via the e-Business Center, Air Services, within thirty (30) days of receipt of the Notice of Violation.

CDAQ received a letter dated May 11, 2011, requesting an extension of time to



comply with the above noted requests. CDAQ granted an extension to June 14, 2011, to comply with the above noted requests.

CDAQ has received and accepted corrected deviation reports and record keeping for 2010 via the e-business center as of July 1, 2011.

CDAQ also received a Title V permit-to-operate application on July 5, 2011, via the e-Business center. This application is incomplete and has not been accepted by CDAQ.

You are still expected to comply with submitting a plan of corrective action to completely cover the mixing/blending tanks while containing paint materials, to the following enforcement representative by July 14, 2011:

You are also required to submit an acceptable correction to the July 5, 2011, Title V permit-to-operate application via the e-Business center by July 14, 2011.

Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Please submit any future correspondence related to this matter to the following enforcement representative:

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
