

As an authorized representative for the above facility, I hereby elect to have the equipment identified above withdrawn by the Cleveland Division of Air Quality. Operation of this source after withdrawal is classified as operating a new air contaminant source, as defined in Ohio Administrative Code Rules-3745-31-01 (I) and is a violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) section 3704.05(F) and (G). ORC Section 3704.99(A) allows for a fine to be imposed for these violations of up to \$25,000 per day.


I understand that the equipment identified above will be taken off the active Ohio EPA record status and will be placed on permanently shut down City and/or State record status.

LETTER OF WARNING FOLLOW-UP LETTER

Dear Mr. Diegidio:

On January 27, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected LAL's, Incorporated (LAL's) located at 8807 Garfield Heights Boulevard in Garfield Heights. CDAQ then issued a Letter of Warning on February 7, 2012, requiring LAL's to submit an invoice demonstrating proof of purchase of a halogenated hydrocarbon detector or a perchloroethylene (PCE) gas analyzer and a copy of two weeks of weekly leak checks utilizing the leak detector. CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action plan dated March 23, 2012, at which time CDAQ received a written statement expressing that emission unit (EU) D002: Permac 30 lb dry to dry cleaning machine is no longer in use. LAL's also informed CDAQ that all dry cleaning would be sent to All Prem Cleaners, Inc. located at 33640 Aurora Road in Solon.

The corrective action plan was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
