SECOND NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failure to Provide Gasoline and Used Oil Annual Throughput Records for Determination of Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) Emissions Compliance

Dear Mr. Karaja:

On 3/14/12, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Exxbo, Inc. located at 11622 Bellaire Rd. in Cleveland. This letter serves as notification that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

On 4/13/12, CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) for failure to provide gasoline and used oil annual throughput records and failure to obtain City Permits to Operate for 2010 and 2011.

On 6/28/12, CDAQ received payment for the City Permits to Operate for 2010 and 2011.

Exxbo, Inc. has yet to provide gasoline and used oil annual throughput totals (gallons) for the period 1/1/11 to 12/31/11 for the purpose of determining VOC emissions compliance. This is a violation of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.05(C), the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09 (DDD)(3)(a)(1) and Permit-to-Install/Operate (PTIO) #P0094637, Part (C)(1)(d)(2)(a,b) and Part (C)(2).

On 3/14/12, the CDAQ inspector explained to you that a less complex permit was available for your facility in the form of a Permit by Rule (PBR) notification.

Additionally, you were advised of free compliance assistance available through the Ohio EPA's Office of Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention (OCAPP).

A PBR Notification form, completion instructions and an OCAPP pamphlet with contact information was provided at the time of the site visit.

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance.



CDAQ requests that Exxbo, Inc. submit gasoline and used oil annual throughput totals (gallons) for the period 1/1/11 to 12/31/11 to the following enforcement representative:

Your written response to this letter must be received by CDAQ within fourteen (14) days of your receipt of this letter. If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, your response must include a timeline for correcting the alleged violations.

Additionally, 2012 City Permit Fees are now due. CDAQ requests that the Exxbo Inc. obtain a City Permit to Operate for 2012 by submitting the City Permit Fee to the following address:

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
