NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Shihadeh:

On September 16, 2011, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Marathon submit:

- a Permit by Rule Notification Form or a Permit-to-Install/Operate application,
- a template that will be used to track required maintenance checks and
- proof of attendance and completion of Stage II training as required by Ohio EPA

CDAQ received a Permit by Rule Notification form dated October 7, 2011.

On October 13, 2011, CDAQ issued a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan requiring Marathon to submit:

- a template that will be used to track required maintenance checks and
- proof of attendance and completion of Stage II training as required by Ohio EPA,

by November 7, 2011.

On October 21, 2011, CDAQ received a letter from Marathon requesting more time to receive required Stage II training as required by Ohio EPA as well as an attachment of a template that will be used to track required maintenance checks.

On October 25, 2011, CDAQ granted an extension to November 25, 2011, for Marathon to comply with submitting proof of attendance and completion of Stage II training as required by Ohio EPA.

CDAQ has received an e-mail dated November 23, 2011, requesting another extension of time to comply with submitting proof of attendance and completion of Stage II training as required by Ohio EPA due to the lack of availability of training classes.

On January 17, 2012, CDAQ received a copy of the Stage II training certification for Asyed Shihadeh.



The corrective action was received and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
