RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Cooley:

On October 17, 2008, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Heidtman Steel Products, Inc. complete a permit to install and operate (PTIO) application for the generation of airborne particulate matter from the transportation of steel coils on unpaved roadways.

CDAQ is in receipt of a letter dated October 27, 2008, stating that the unpaved areas are being watered on a daily basis and that you are submitting the appropriate permit application for this emissions source. You are expected to comply with your corrective measures and to submit the permit application for unpaved roadways by November 30, 2008.

Failure to comply may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. 

Notice of violation; failure to obtain a permit to install and operate for unpaved roadways.

Heidtman Steel was not aware of a need for a permit to operate a vehicle on an unpaved road. Since notice of the violation, we have purchased a large water tank and spray bar and are currently watering down the roadway on a daily basis. Further, we are in the process of obtaining the necessary permit to allow us to properly operate on an unpaved roadway. Finally, we are working on a long term solution to remove the coils from that area permanently.

When we started storing coils outside, we believed that it would be a temporary situation. The price of steel rose to an all time high and people were buying more steel than they could use as it rose. The business climate is such a mess, that it is taking a longer time than forecasted to deplete the inventory.

I assure you that Heidtman Steel strives to follow all regulations and be a clean corporate citizen.
