NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER

Dear Mr. Hukill:

On September 14, 2009, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requiring Hukill Chemical Corporation (Hukill) to submit a corrective action plan stating how the emission limitation on emission unit (EU) P015: Drum processing and drum auger/Hochmeyer, will not be exceeded in the future, submit a corrected, electronic quarterly deviation report for EU P015 and begin submitting electronic semi-annual deviation reports beginning the second half of 2009 for EU P012: Storm water air stripper and EU P015.

CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action dated September 28, 2009, stating there was an inputting error in the number of drums recorded that resulted in excess emissions being reported for EU P015. CDAQ agreed to accept a corrected, hardcopy deviation report for EU P015 as electronic submittal was not required at the time of the deviation. CDAQ also agreed to allow an electronic submittal of the first half 2009 semi-annual deviation reports for EUs P012 and P015 instead of an electronic submittal of the second half 2009 semi-annual deviation reports for these EUs.

The corrective action was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in
