**NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failure to submit a quarterly deviation report for the third quarter of 2010**

Dear Mr. Hukill:

The Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) is issuing this Notice of Violation regarding Hukill Chemical Corporation located at 7013 Krick Road in Bedford. This letter serves as notification that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

Hukill Chemical Corporation has yet to submit a quarterly deviation report for the third quarter (July, August and September) of 2010, which was due by October 31, 2010. This is a violation of Permit to Install (PTI) 13-04102 Part III. A. IV. 2. A. and b. for P012: Wastewater Air Stripper, PTI 13-04067 Part III. A. IV. 1. a. and b. for P015: Drum Processing Operation and PTI 13-04099 Part I. A. 2. b. for P016: Hydrofluoric Acid Filling Line.

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that Hukill Chemical Corporation electronically submit a quarterly deviation report for the third quarter of 2010 within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this letter.

If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, a written response that includes a timeline for correcting the alleged violations must be received by CDAQ within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this letter.



Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
