Dear Mr. Patel:

On June 20, 2011, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Berea Sunoco submit a completed Permit By Rule (PBR) application form, provide gasoline deliveries for July 2011 and obtain a Stage II Compliance Specialist Certificate for a manager or operator.

CDAQ is in receipt of a completed PBR application form and gasoline deliveries for July 2011 dated July 18, 2011. You are expected to comply with obtaining a Stage II Compliance Specialist Certificate for a manager or operator and submitting a copy of the certificate to CDAQ's Andrew Marantides by August 30, 2011.

Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
