NOTICE OF VIOLATION: NO STAGE II TEST PERFORMED IN 2006**

Dear Mr. Abuzahri:

On January 3, 2007, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected UPM #210 Marathon located at 3580 Ridge Road in Brooklyn. This letter serves as notification that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

UPM #210 Marathon is required to perform and comply with any vapor control system test specified by CARB or included in permit-to-install (PTI) 13-02106. There is no evidence that the required static leak or air-to-liquid tests were completed within calendar year 2006. This is a violation of PTI 13-02106, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09(DDD)(2) and (3), and Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.05(C) and (G).

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that UPM #210 Marathon submit a corrective action plan within fourteen (14) days of your receipt of this letter to the following enforcement representative:

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
