NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failure to submit semi-annual deviation reports, and failure to submit an applicability notification

Dear Mr. Kelly Munhollon:

On November 10, and November 20, 2009, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected St. Ives (D.B.A. Angstrom Graphics), located at 4437 East 49th Street in Cuyahoga Heights. CDAQ conducted a follow-up inspection on November 20, 2009, in order to perform a Method 9 Test, and receive clarification of materials submitted. This letter serves as notification that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

Angstrom Graphics has failed to submit an applicability notification pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-22: Control of volatile organic compound emissions from offset lithographic printing and letterpress printing facilities. This notification was due June 1, 2009, per OAC Rule 3745-21-22(J)(1).

Angstrom Graphics operation of emission units (EUs) K003: Komori web offset lithographic printing line, K004: Harris web offset lithographic printing line, K005: 2-color Heidelberg sheet-fed offset lithographic printing press, K008: 6-color Heidelberg heat-set web offset lithographic printing line, K009: 6-color Man Roland sheet-fed offset lithographic printing press, and K010: 8-color sheet-fed offset lithographic printing press are in violation of their Permit Part I: General Terms and Conditions (A)(1)(c)(iii), and OAC Rule 3745-77-07(C)(4), for failing to submit semi-annual deviation reports, since October 31, 2000.

CDAQ requests that Angstrom Graphics submit an applicability notification as outlined in OAC Rule 3745-21-22(J)(1) and begin submitting semi-annual deviation reports for EUs K003, K004, K005, K008, K009, and K010 through Air Services,



starting with the second half of 2009 due no later than January 31, 2010.

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, a written response must be received by CDAQ within 30 days of receipt of this letter that includes a timeline for correcting the alleged violations.

CDAQ also requests that Angstrom Graphics update their facility profile in Air Services to reflect their current ownership status, within 30 days of receipt of this letter.

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and/or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
