RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: Notice of Violation for B008 emissions
violation and Quarterly Deviation reporting omissions for B008 and P047**

Dear Mr. Mackin:

On 06/13/2007, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Charter Steel submit quarterly deviation reports for B008 that accurately reflect exceedences of allowable permit levels not properly reflected in previous quarterly deviation reports for P047 (since no reports were previously submitted) and submit an administrative modification to address calculation errors for the carbon monoxide (CO) and nitrogen oxide (NOx) allowable levels for P029. CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action plan dated 7/2/2007.

You are expected to submit accurate quarterly deviation reports including on-going reference to the calculation errors for P029 by 7/31/2007. The inclusion of P047 in quarterly deviation reporting is unnecessary until installation of this unit is complete. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan, and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
