NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Mackin:

On 6/13/2007, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requiring Charter Steel to submit quarterly deviation reports for B008 that accurately reflect exceedences of allowable permit levels; quarterly deviation reports for P047 (since no reports were previously submitted) and to submit an administrative modification to address calculation errors for the carbon monoxide (CO) and nitrogen oxide (NOx) allowable levels for P029.

CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action plan dated 7/2/2007.

Charter Steel submitted revised deviation reports specific to B008 and will continue to do so until the issuance of the permit-to-install (PTI) modification. No deviation reports will be required for P047 until the installation of the emissions unit is complete. Through discussion with CDAQ, it was agreed that a notation to the quarterly deviation reports for P029, acknowledging the rounding errors for the CO and NOx allowable levels in PTI # 13-02840 (mod.), will be sufficient in lieu of submitting an application for a PTI modification.

The corrective action plan was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
