Dear Mr. Lay:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) issued one or more Permit(s)-To-Install and Operate (PTIO) for the facility identified above. Standard terms and conditions in a PTIO require an annual Permit Evaluation Report (PER) for each emissions unit contained in the permit. The PER(s) which was due for the reporting period 04/01/2011 through 03/31/2012 was not submitted by the due date, May 15, 2012.

Also, please note that, as of this writing, as noted in our correspondence dated July 11, 2012, Ohio EPA has yet to receive Seagate's Non-Title V (NTV) Emissions report for calendar years 2010 and 2011. This report is also past due.

Both reports must either be completed using the hard copy forms provided to you with the PER reminder letter or the NTV emissions report past due letter, or electronically via the eBusiness Center - Air Services at ebiz.epa.ohio.gov. Each submission of an incomplete, inaccurate or late report is in violation of the terms and conditions of the applicable PTIO. Violations of the terms and conditions of a PTIO permit are violations of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3704.05.

The company's written response to this letter is required by August 28, 2012. It should be submitted to Ohio EPA, Northwest District Office and contain the reports identified above.
