Notice of Violation: Failure to submit quarterly deviation reports; Failure to conduct weekly visual inspections for any liquid leaks of petroleum solvent; Failure to maintain records of annual petroleum solvent consumption.

Dear Mr. Nandigam:

On 12/19/07, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected All Prem Cleaners, Inc. located at 34218 Aurora Rd. in Solon, OH 44139. This letter serves as notification that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.04(C) and Permit to Install (PTI) #13-04692, Part I.A.2(b). Failure to submit quarterly deviation reports since issuance of PTI 12/12/06.

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-21-09(BB)(4)(a), ORC 3704.05(C) and PTI #13-04692, Part II.C.1. Failure to maintain records of annual petroleum solvent consumption since issuance of PTI 12/12/06.

ORC 3704.05(C) and PTI #13-04692, Part II.B.2. Failure to conduct weekly visual inspections for any liquid leaks of petroleum solvent since issuance of PTI 12/12/06.

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that All Prem Cleaners, Inc. submit all quarterly deviation reports for 2007; a visual inspection checklist with current data included; and petroleum solvent consumption records for 2007 along with a copy of the Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for DF-2000 Fluid to the following enforcement representative:

Your written response to this letter must be received by CDAQ within fourteen (14) days of your receipt of this letter. If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, your response must include a timeline for correcting the alleged violations.

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

Free assistance with state and/or federal regulations, rules, laws or permit conditions can be provided at no charge through Ohio EPA Office of Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention (OCAPP). OCAPP can be contacted at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/ocapp> or (614) 644-3469 or (800) 329-7518. CDAQ makes no guarantee that the facility will meet the qualifying guidelines established by the OCAPP.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
