RECEIPT OF CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN: NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

Dear Ms. Browsky:

On May 15, 2008, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation to CardPak, Inc. (CardPak) regarding emissions testing on CardPak's K003 emissions unit. Applicable testing was not conducted six months prior to the expiration of CardPak's Title V permit.

CDAQ is in receipt of a written corrective action response, dated June 3, 2008, stating that CardPak will conduct the applicable K003 emissions testing. Furthermore, CDAQ is in receipt of CardPak's Intent to Test (ITT) notification form dated June 5, 2008.

You are expected to comply with the anticipated emissions testing, currently scheduled for July 10, 2008. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. 
