Install/Operate (PTIO)

Dear Mr. Swanson:

On 12/27/10, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Henkel Corporation submit emissions calculations or provide the reason that qualifies an emissions unit (EU) for Exempt or DeMinimis Status and/or Permit-to-Install/Operate (PTIO) applications (for EUs that cannot be determined to be Exempt or DeMinimis) for all EUs indicated. CDAQ is in receipt of a compliance deadline extension request dated 1/10/11.

You are expected to comply with providing the requested calculations, qualifying explanations or PTIO applications by 3/4/11. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
