**NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failure to submit all quarterly deviation reports, semi-annual ongoing compliance status reports, annual Title V Fee Emissions Report, annual Emissions Inventory Summary and annual Title V Compliance Certification for 2011**

Dear Mr. Hadgis:

On July 20, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Areyway Acquisitions, Inc. located at 8525 Clinton Road and 3700 Ridge Road in Brooklyn. This letter serves as notification that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

Areyway Acquisitions, Inc. failed to submit quarterly deviation reports for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters of 2011, semi-annual ongoing compliance status reports for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> halves of 2011, an annual Title V Fee Emissions Report (FER) for 2011, an annual Emissions Inventory Summary (EIS) for 2011 and an annual Title V Compliance Certification for 2011. The failure to submit the required reports listed above are violations of Areyway Acquisitions, Inc.'s Title V Permit issued on April 3, 2002.

Areyway Acquisitions, Inc. was already cited in a Notice of Violation dated May 22, 2012 by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) for not submitting an annual Title V FER or an annual EIS for 2011.

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that Areyway



Acquisitions, Inc. electronically submit the nine (9) reports listed above via the eBusiness Center within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter.

If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, a written response must include a timeline for correcting the alleged violations.

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
