**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Rosby:

On May 3, and 18, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Rosby Resource Recycling, Inc. (Rosby) located at 54 East Schaaf Road, in Brooklyn Heights.

On June 6, 2012, CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation requesting that Rosby complete the following:

1. Submit completed Permit-to-Install/Operate (PTIO) applications and Emission Activity Category (EAC) forms for sixteen (16) unpermitted Emission Units (EUs);
2. Submit a two (2) week sample of the daily roadway inspections; and
3. Re-submit a corrected 2011 Permit Evaluation Report.

On June 27, 2012, CDAQ received a copy of a two (2) week sample of daily roadway inspections, and a letter requesting a 30 day extension for submitting the PTIO applications and EAC forms. On July 3, 2012, CDAQ received a corrected 2011 Permit Evaluation Report.

On July 16, 2012, CDAQ issued a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan granting an extension to submit the requested PTIO applications and EAC forms to August 1, 2012.

On July 31, 2012, CDAQ received the requested PTIO applications and EAC forms. CDAQ performed a preliminary completeness review of the applications on August 14, 2012.



The appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
