**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Obloy:

On April 10, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Kyron Plating located at 1336 W. 114th Street in Cleveland. On May 3, 2012, CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation requesting the submittal of a renewal permit-to-install/operate (PTIO) application for the continued operation of emission unit (EU) P001: decorative hexavalent chromium electroplating tank. CDAQ also requested the submittal of a new PTIO application for your operation of EU P002: decorative trivalent chromium electroplating tank. In addition, CDAQ requested a corrective action plan indicating how Kyron Plating will comply with National Emission Standards for Chromium Emissions under Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 63, Subpart N in regards to the operation of EUs P001 and P002.

CDAQ received PTIO applications for EUs P001 and P002 on July 1, 2012; however, they were missing important information and were returned to you for proper completion. Subsequently, on July 13, 2012, CDAQ issued a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan (RCAP) to Kyron Plating that acknowledged your corrective actions in a letter dated June 1, 2012. The RCAP also requested the completion and submittal of PTIO applications for EUs P001 and P002 to CDAQ within thirty days of your receipt of the RCAP.

CDAQ is in receipt of new PTIO applications for EUs P001 and P002 as of August 10, 2012. The applications were received and appropriate steps were taken to bring each source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
