Dear Mr. Cozean:

This letter is in response to the submission of both the 3rd and 4th quarter of 2006 Title V deviation reports received on February 7, 2007.

As you are aware, Composite Technologies disclosed the following violations:

3rd Quarter 2006 Deviation Report

1. report due 10/31/06, but not received until 2/07/07;
2. baghouse pressure drops not being monitored or recorded;
3. clean up solvent not being tracked; and
4. emission limitations exceeded for both P902 and P905 on 8/16/06.

4th Quarter 2006 Deviation Report

1. report due 1/31/06 but not received until 2/07/07;
2. baghouse pressure drops not being monitored or recorded; and
3. emission limitation exceeded on P905 on 10/02/06 and 10/03/06.

Be advised that this situation constitutes a violation of Ohio Revised Code 3704.05(J)(2).

Please submit within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this letter your proposed resolutions to these violations that will ensure that they do not occur in the future.

This notice of violation in no way waives the rights of Ohio EPA or USEPA to pursue additional enforcement action in this matter, including the assessment of civil penalties. The decision to pursue, or decline to pursue, additional enforcement in this matter will be made at a later date.
